

WORLD HERITAGE EXAMPLES LABELS

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK, TANZANIA

This amazing natural landscape is famous for its annual migration of over 1.5 million wildebeest and 250,000 zebra.

RAPA NUI NATIONAL PARK, EASTER ISLAND

The people that settled this island around c. A.D. 300 established a unique tradition of monumental sculpture and architecture.

From the 10th to the 16th century this society built shrines and erected enormous stone figures which can still be seen today.

THE PYRAMID FIELDS, EGYPT

The capital of the Old Kingdom of Egypt has some extraordinary monuments, including rock tombs, temples and pyramids.

In ancient times, the site was considered one of the Seven Wonders of the World.

THE TAJ MAHAL, INDIA

An immense mausoleum of white marble, built in Agra between 1631 and 1648 by order of the Mughal emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his favourite wife, the Taj Mahal is the jewel of Muslim art in India and one of the universally admired masterpieces of the world's heritage.

CORNWALL AND WEST DEVON MINING LANDSCAPE, GREAT BRITAIN

This landscape's deep underground mines, engine houses, foundries, ports and harbours reflect amazing innovation which, in the early 19th century, enabled the region to produce two-thirds of the world's supply of copper.

The substantial remains are a testimony to the contribution Cornwall and West Devon made to the Industrial Revolution in the rest of Britain.
